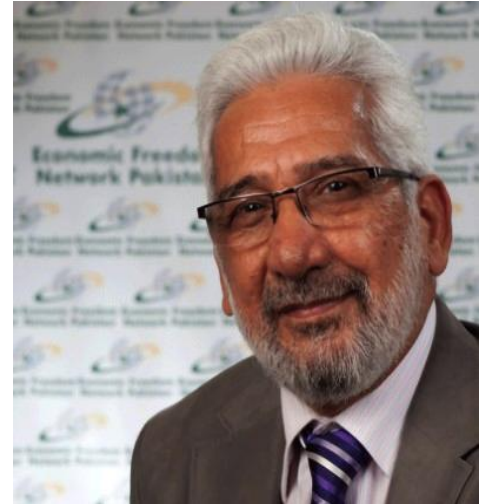


Zubair Ahmed Malik
